Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Continue to read age appropriate books whether it be first thing in the morning or at bedtime. Encourage your child to segment the words themselves.Continue to practise reading tricky words (attached)
Writing/Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Monday – Practise your phase 3 sounds – j,v,w,x Write each one and a word starting with each sound.Tuesday – Practise your phase 3 sounds – y, z, zz, qu. Write each one and a word starting with each soundWednesday – Practise your phase 3 sounds – ch, sh, th, ng. Write each one and a word starting with each soundThursday – Practise your phase 3 sounds – ai, ee, igh, oa. Write each one and a word starting with each soundFriday – Recap all of phase 3 sounds from this week. Write each one and a new word starting with each soundCan you write 2 sentences about what you miss from school, remember to use your sound mats.Practise formation of digraphs and trigraphs. Can you recognise them all?
