Draw a dragon or a castle using 2D shapes or make one using 3d shapes. You could include a list of the shapes you have used. For a challenge, describe their properties using mathematical language.

Research a life cycle of an animal. Can you draw it in your homework book?

Create your own Maths board game. To play with a friend. It can include +, -, x, ÷

Pretend that you have just returned from a seeing a real dragon! Write a diary entry about your experience.

Think of all the foods you might eat if you lived in a royal castle. Create a menu full of foods you and your dragon might eat!

Create an animal shape poem.

Draw an animal of your choice and write a poem inside about that animal. Can you describe the animal?

Find 5 facts about a real castle of your choice. Can you use these 5 facts to create a fact file or leaflet?

Go around your house and see how many different size and shape bottles you can find. How much can each bottle hold and then order them from largest to smallest

Imagine your dragon was 6 metres tall. Measure some tall objects with a tape measure and write down their heights in order.

Choose a two-digit number and write as many facts about that number as you can. Can you + - x ÷ with that number? Is it odd or even?

Practice your 2, 5 or 10 times tables. Can you jump, clap, march while saying them?
